



Susan Anderson Nash Fund

The Susan Anderson Nash Fund (SAN) was established to honor Susan Anderson Nash, a long-time beloved WWS Children's Garden teacher. The fund provides grants to high school students whose needs exceed what can be met through the regular financial aid process.

Any high school student, including rising ninth graders, whose family applies for financial aid and qualifies for more than 50% tuition assistance has their full need met by a combination of regular financial aid and a grant from SAN funds.

The application process for receiving SAN funds is as follows:

- The high school or rising ninth grade family must apply for tuition assistance through our regular financial aid process.
- Families whose financial need is determined to exceed 50% will receive additional assistance through SAN to meet their high school student's full need.
- Families receiving SAN funds will be notified of the amount at the same time they receive their financial aid award.

We are grateful to be able to offer this additional financial assistance to our high school families in honor of Susan's contribution to our school community. We think she would whole-heartedly approve of the opportunity it offers for many more students to have the crowning experience of a full Waldorf education.
