2019-2020 ANNUAL TUITION AGREEMENT

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Period of Enrollment: I/We understand and agree that the term of this Annual Tuition Agreement ("Agreement") shall be for the entire school year, or, in the case of a student entering after the school year has begun, from the date of enrollment to the last day of the school year.

Commitment for the Full School Year: I/We understand and agree that there is no reduction, refund, credit or other allowance made for snow days, absences, illness, missed classes due to tutoring or other programs, dismissal or withdrawal, except as provided through the 'Early Withdrawal Policy'. I/We understand and agree that the one-time application fee and the annual registration fees are non-refundable and nontransferable. For calculation purposes, the number of days in the school year for all students is deemed to be 175 days.

Annual Registration Fee: I/We understand that a non-refundable and non-transferable registration fee is due with my/our Agreement, to secure a place for my/our child(ren) for the 2019-2020 school year. I/We understand that registration fees are not applied to tuition. Late fees may be assessed for Agreements submitted after the due date.

Tuition, Fees, Refundable Deposit, and other Payments: I/We understand and agree that the Tuition and Fee Schedule and the Refundable Deposit Agreement are incorporated by reference into this Annual Tuition Agreement in their entirety.

Mandatory Refundable Deposit: I/We understand and agree that the School requires that, in addition to ordinary tuition and fees, I/we maintain a deposit in cash with the School, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Refundable Deposit Agreement. I/We further understand and agree that, in accordance with the terms of the Refundable Deposit Agreement, my/our entitlement to receive a return of my/our refundable deposit shall be subject to my/our payment of all past due tuition and fees in respect to my/our child(ren), and the School shall have the right to withhold repayment of my/our refundable deposit and, in its sole discretion, to apply it to any such past due tuition and fees.

Multiple Child Adjustment: I/We understand that, if applicable, a 10% adjustment for my/our second child and a 20% adjustment for my/our third and subsequent child(ren), on tuition only, has been automatically applied on this Agreement. I/We may also apply for Financial Aid.

Financial Aid ("Aid"): I/We understand and agree that if Aid has been awarded to me/us and is included in this Agreement, my/our signature(s) indicates my/our acceptance of the Aid and my/our understanding and agreement of the following: 1) Aid applies only to tuition, is not retroactive and it is my/our obligation to notify the School of any increase in my/our income or assets. 2) If Aid is being applied to more than one child, withdrawal of one of the children from the School will not result in the Aid for that child being applied to other children in the family. 3) The School requires that parents not share with others the particulars of awards received. Breaches of this confidentiality agreement may require a review and potential repeal of financial aid awards. If this Agreement is not accepted by the due date, the Aid award may be reallocated to another family. Monthly Payments: Other than the annual or semi-annual payment plan, which allows for a discount, I/We understand that there are fees associated with other payment plans or payment methods, which the School may require me/us to pay.

Late Payment/Returned Check Fee Policy: I/We understand that if I/we miss a tuition payment or an automatic payment is returned by my/our bank, I/we will be charged a missed payment fee and may incur a similar fee from my/our bank. I/We agree to pay a returned payment fee for any checks or FACTS payments returned by my/our bank unpaid. Returned checks will not be re-deposited.

Payment Delinquency: For accounts in arrears exceeding the late payment policy guidelines, I/we agree to pay all costs of collection of delinquent payments, including, without limitation, reasonable collection agency fees, attorney's fees and court costs.

Past Due Balances: I/We understand that all past due tuition and fees must be, in the opinion of the School, current by the first day of school in order for my/our child(ren) to begin attending classes. Any request for an exception must be made in writing to the Operations Manager. Any outstanding balance, including amounts due for billings other than tuition (e.g., aftercare or tutoring), will be added to my bill and, if I am enrolled in FACTS, will be charged to me through my FACTS account.

Scholastic Records: I/We understand that the School reserves the right to withhold any diploma, certificate, written reports, transcripts or other scholastic records, if payments of any or all tuition and other amounts due the School under the terms of this agreement are not current.

Early Withdrawal Policy: Withdrawal before School Begins: I/We understand that if I/we give notice in writing of my/our decision to withdraw my/our child(ren), and such notice is received by the Business Office prior to June 1, 2019, my/our financial obligation for the 2019-2020 tuition and fees will be limited to the non-refundable application and registration fees. After June 1, 2019, if I/we decide to withdraw my/our child(ren), I/we understand that I/we am/are obligated to pay 50% of the remaining tuition for the full school year. I/We also understand that the School, at its sole discretion, may place conditions for a student's continuance at any time.

Exclusion from School: I/We understand and agree that the School shall have the right to exclude any student from attendance, temporarily or permanently, under any circumstances deemed, at the sole and exclusive discretion of the School, to be interfering with the health, safety or educational development of the student or any other student(s) in the School. The School also reserves the unconditional right to suspend or dismiss any student whose progress or conduct is unsatisfactory. The School further reserves the right to deny continued enrollment, or reenrollment, to any student if the School reasonably concludes that the actions of a parent or guardian are inconsistent with the establishment and/or maintenance of a positive working relationship between the School and that student's parents or guardians.

Tutoring, Consultation or Special Services: I/We agree to be responsible for payment of any tutoring, external consultation or special services which the School does not provide as part of its core curriculum, and which the School deems necessary for the student to perform at grade level.

Images/Photos: I/We understand that digital images/photographs of my/our child(ren) and/or schoolwork may be taken at school events, classroom, assemblies, performances, or sports events. I/We hereby give the School permission to use them in school-related publications and publicity efforts.

Responsibility for Waste, Loss, or Damage: I/We agree to be responsible, upon written request by the School, for the replacement cost of any supplies, materials, or equipment that the student breaks, damages or wastes. I/We recognize that the School is not responsible for damages to, or theft of, personal property brought to or left on school grounds.
